Welcome back to term 5 of the school year. We would also like to take this opportunity to welcome the new families joining us this term including our new 2-year-olds who will be in Sunshine class. We hope everyone had an enjoyable Easter break and managed to get out and about and have lots of fun with your families. It has been lovely looking at all of your Tapestry observations showing us what you have been doing during the holiday and also following our suggested home learning activities.

Minor Alterations

We are very pleased to say that the works for the Sunshine 2-year-old provision have gone extremely well. We have had some small changes to the layout in nursery. We have removed two partitions and added one to create a new space. We have uploaded videos to Tapestry to show you the changes and how this affects plans for children being dropped off and collected. Please be patient while we make tweaks to make any transitions as smooth as possible for the children. Please note that the lunch boxes are moved into nursery once the handovers have been completed.

We are currently looking to recruit a full-time level 3 Early years practitioner as well as a lunch time nurture assistant.


Focus Stories in Rainbow class

Absences and Lateness



Please ensure that you bring your child to nursery on time each day. If on the very rare occasion you are going to be late please call us to let us know. It is important that the children arrive on time as it impacts the whole group if the team needs to be interrupted to welcome a late child. With this in mind we will be leaving the doors open until 9.10am and 12.55pm. If you are late

unfortunately you will need to bring your child to reception and be asked to wait with them until the end of the group time which could take up to 20 minutes.

If your child is going to be absent from nursery please call us on the 1st day. We have a duty of care to follow up with anyone that has not called us to let us know why their child is absent. Thank you for your understanding. School times are as follows:

9am – 12pm for mornings, 9am – 3.45pm for a full day and 12.45 – 3.45pm for afternoon sessions.

School Transitions

For those of you with children due to start school in September 2024, Emails and letters offering places will have been sent out on 16th April 2024, emails should have been received by 5pm. Letters are posted 2nd class and may take up to 5 working days to arrive. You must accept your child's place by 1st May 2024. You can use this link <u>http://ow.ly/OzF450Eq708</u>. As part of the preparations for the move to Primary School we will be sending out invitations for partner schools to visit the nursery. This will enable them to meet the children's key person and spend some time getting to know the children. We will let you know the dates of these visits once they are confirmed.

Sun Cream and Sun Hats

As we look forward to the warmer weather, please supply a named hat for your child that can be left in nursery and apply sun cream **before they arrive each day**. We will supply factor 50 for sensitive skin so we can re-apply as appropriate. We will continue to ensure the children have access to plenty of fluids and that they have shade in the gardens in the warmer weather.
